PREAMBLE

The Fisheries Technocrats Forum, Chennai was started on 25-6-1990 and got registered under the Tamil Nadu State Societies Act 1978 with effect from 18-3-1992. The initial membership was 28 during 1991-92, which has steadily increased in the following years and stood at 126 during 2015-16. This included 86 Life members, 4 Corporate members, 31 Members and 5 Student Members.

ACTIVITIES


- 1. Twenty Fourth Annual General Body Meeting: The Twenty Fourth Annual meeting of the General Body (April 2014-March 2015) was held on 11th July 2015 under the chairmanship of Dr A.R. Thirunavukkarasu, Chairman, which was attended by 24 members out of the total membership of 119. The proceedings of the Twenty Third Annual General Body Meeting held on 14-6-2014 (for the period April 2013 March 2014) were approved and adopted. - 2. Memberships: The details of the membership from 1991-92 to 2015-16 are given below.



- 3. Branch of FTF at Madurai: A branch entitled as South Tamil Nadu Branch of the Fisheries Technocrats Forum was established at Madurai during 2014-15. - 6) Conduct of 1-day National Workshop on "Marketing Strategies for newly cultured Fishes in India" in collaboration with CIBA, Chennai in February 2016, 7) Approval for new fixed deposits, 8) Mr. A. Sreenivasan's Endowment lecture, 9) Forwarding of one of the Forum's member's application for seeking WWF, 10) Payment of balance amount to the expense incurred in Sea bass workshop, 11) Postponement of 1-day Workshop on Fish Marketing from February 2016 to March 2016, 12) Printing of the Proceedings of Seminar on "Development of Fisheries in Water Deficient Regions", 13) Finalization of the Proceedings of 1-day National Workshop on "Marketing Strategies for Newly Cultured Fishes in India", 14) Conduct of the proposed 25th Annual General Body Meeting of the Chennai Forum in July 2016 and 16) Renewal of one of the older fixed deposits.
- 5. Monthly meetings: Totally 10 monthly meetings were held at the Library Hall of the Directorate of Fisheries, Chennai at every Second Saturday during 2015-16. Dr. A.R. Thirunavukkarasu, Chairman chaired the meeting in April, June, August to October 2015 and February & March 2016. Dr. R. Soundararajan, Vice-Chairman presided over the meetings in May 2015 & January 2016 in the absence of the Chairman. Mr. V. Venkatesan chaired the meeting in November 2015, when both the Chairman and Vice-Chairman could not able to attend the meeting due to their preoccupation. There was no monthly meeting in July 2015 as the Twenty Fourth Annual General Body meeting took place. The library hall which was affected by the north-east monsoon rains, was not available in December 2015. 6. Conduct of 1-day National Workshop on "Marketing Strategies for Newly Cultured Fishes in India" by the Forum and CIBA, Chennai:

The 1-day National Workshop was conducted in collaboration with the Central Institute of Brackishwater Aquaculture on 16-03-2016 at CIBA Auditorium, Chennai. Dr. K.K. Vijayan, Director, CIBA presided over the inaugural function, while Dr. P. Ravichandran, Member Secretary, Coastal Aquaculture Authority, Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India inaugurated the workshop. The welcome address was by Dr. A.R. Thirunavukkarasu, Chairman, FTF, while the felicitations were offered by Dr. V.V. Sugunan, Former Assistant Director General of ICAR & Senior Consultant, NFDB, Hyderabad and Dr. S. Santhana Krishnan, M/s Maritech Technologies, Chennai. Dr. M. Kumaran, Principal Scientist, CIBA & Member, FTF proposed a vote of thanks.

Technical Session III: Future Strategies for Speedy Disposal of Cultured Fishes Recommendations

A total of 129 personnel (CIBA, Chennai 44; Madras RC of CMFRI 11; Mandapam RC 1; CAA, Chennai 2; NFDB, Hyderabad 1; RGCA, Andhra Pradesh, 1; NIOT, Chennai 1; MPEDA, Chennai 2; Tamil Nadu Dept. of Fisheries 5; Aquaculture Industry 5; Fish Marketing sector 3; Colleges Professors & Students 8; FTF, Chennai 26; FTF, Madurai 2; All India Radio, Press & Television reporters 17). attended the workshop.

The expenditure has met from the funds received from National Fisheries Development Board, Hyderabad (Rs. 50,000/- paid to CIBA, Chennai) and Coastal Aquaculture Authority, Chennai (Rs. 50,000/- paid to FTF, Chennai). The total grant received by FTF amounted to Rs. 50,000/-.

- 7. Publication: Proceedings of the 1-day Workshop on "Aquaculture of Sea Bass-Way forward for commercial production" conducted in January 2015, were got ready and circulated among the members and end-users either through hard copy or soft copy in August 2015.
- 8. Tenure of elected office bearers: The present term of the Chairman is for one year i.e. from 1-4-2015 to 31-3-2016 and the Chairman will continue to hold the office till his successor takes over for the period 2016-17 after the conduct of elections at the Twenty Fifth Annual General Body Meeting, vide Rule 24 of Chapter VI of the Bye-laws of the Forum. The tenure of all other elected officials such as Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Executive Council members is also for one year i.e. from 1-4-2015 to 31-3-2016 vide Rule 25, 26, 27 and 28 of Chapter VI of the Bye-laws of the Forum. Thirunavukkarasu, Chairman declared the amendments to the bye-laws brought by Mr. Kathirvel, Secretary is adopted. The amendments may be submitted to the Registrar of Society (Madras Central), for certified copy.


